ANNOUNCEMENT OF INDIAN WOMEN'S TEAM FOR 6th AIBA WORLD WOMEN'S BOXING CHAMPIONSHIPS AT BARBADOS

Indian Boxing Federation is pleased to announce the names of the 10 member Women's Boxing Team for the 6th AIBA World Women's Boxing Championships at Bridgetown, Barbados from 09 – 19 September 2010. A total of 306 boxers from 75 different countries are now registered for this edition of the World Boxing Championships.

The number of participants has increased by more than 50 per cent compared with the 2008 edition, which was held in Ningbo, China, even though the number of weight categories has since been reduced from 13 to 10. Furthermore, the number of participating countries has increased by almost 80%, from 42 in 2008 to 75 for the 2010 edition.

The Indian Women's Boxing Team will leave Delhi for Barbados in the early hours of 05 September 2010 and return on 20 September 2010. The Competition this time will be extremely tough as all Boxing Nations are earnestly preparing their Boxers for the London Olympic Games 2012 where Women's Boxing has been introduced for the first time in 3 weight categories (51 kgs, 60 kgs & 75 kgs). The Asian Games at Guangzhou, China in November 2010 will also feature Women's Boxing with the above mentioned 3 weight categories.
